Club has developed new and successful community partnerships with other outside groups and organizations.

Club has initiated or joined in unique and sustainable local or international projects.

Club has developed and successfully completed an impactful Rotary Public Image Campaign and that achieved the outcomes relative to the plan identified goals.

Enhance Engagement

Club has successfully completed youth engagement activities.

Club has completed service projects and engaged Rotarians and Non-Rotarians.

Club has provided (new) service opportunities for members to remain engaged.

Increase Our Ability to Adapt

Club has sought new perspectives to strengthen Rotary and ideas to create lasting change.
